# Haunted House

### FIESTA4HOPE

### DESCRIPTION

Event around Halloween in which many volunteers organize a haunted house for the community to attend with refreshments for sale afterwards.

### STEPS FOR HOW IT WORKS

- Caution those bringing younger children to do so at their own risk (might be easily scared by content within the haunted house).
- Charge a \$1 admission fee to all who enter the haunted house and only let groups with a maximum of 5 people in at a time so as to not overwhelm those acting inside the haunted house
- Prepare all volunteers before the event to make sure that their roles and responsibilities as their characters are clear and to prevent injury to those who come.
- Have numerous club members scattered around to monitor the operation.
- Once each group finishes, direct them to the room outside the haunted house/in the room over with refreshments for sale so that all attendees can interact & purchase fall treats.

## REQUIREMENTS / MATERIALS

- Volunteers to play roles (zombies, mummies, etc.) within the haunted house that can come prepared in proper costumes and makeup
- Have the event fully planned a few weeks before it takes place in order to have one or two rehearsals before the haunted house to ensure that those acting as characters within the haunted house are ready to act their part
- Designated location for event (ideally school gym/cafeteria)
- Decorations (could rent flashing lights for inside the haunted house
- Club members to operate the collection of money for admission to the haunted house, to be on standby in case of emergency within the haunted house, and to collect money in the refreshment portion
- Volunteers to set up and clean up the haunted house location
- Volunteers to bring in refreshments to be sold to attendees prior to going inside the haunted house

#### EXPENSES

- Money for venue of the haunted house if unable to hold in school gym or cafeteria
- Rental of certain materials (flashing lights, props)
